## OBJECTS OF THE SCHEME

A need has also been felt to empower weavers to chart out a sustainable path for growth and diversification in line with the emerging market trends.

The IHDS is an attempt to facilitate the sustainable development of handloom weavers located in and outside the cluster into a cohesive self managing & competitive socio-economic unit.

In order to achieve the planned growth of the Handloom Sector and pave the path for its healthy development, the Govt. of India has launched Integrated Handloom Development Scheme containing State participation in the financial pattern.

The scheme is cohesive attempt to develop the entire sector irrespective of its present location and identification wherever it may be. Total 5 clusters and 42 groups are proposed in the scheme for which administrative approval and Budget provision of Rs.441.10 which comprises of Central Share 295.20 lakhs and State Share Rs. 145.90 Lakhs.
