Terms & Conditions (Only for shortlisted entries from phase I)

Additional Terms & Conditions:

1. The contest is open to all citizens of India only.
2. Every participant, individual or a group have to submit the entries through MyGov Portal
3. Entries received through any other medium will not be considered for the competition.
4. The User Interface should not contain any provocative, objectionable or inappropriate content.
5. The participation can be individual or in a group of Max 5 Persons.
6. Every participant can download the existing buyer seller app from Google play store (search MH-TexApp) for reference and idea URL for Tex App <https://play.google.com/store/apps/details?id=com.directoratetextiles>
7. Wireframe Design must be developed without changing the idea and the concept of TexApp.
8. Every participant should use logo of the Commissionerate in their design.
9. The ‘User Interface Development’ must be original and should not violate any provision of the Indian Copyright Act, 1957. Plagiarism would not be allowed. Anyone found infringing on other’s copyright would be disqualified from the competition. Commissionerate does not bear any responsibility for copyright violations or infringements of intellectual property carried out by the participant.
10. Entries that are automatically generated by computer, completed by third parties or in bulk reconstructed, forged or tampered with will be summarily rejected.
11. The MyGov profile of the applicant should be accurate and updated for further communication. This includes the participant’s name, photo, e-mail ID, mobile number. Entries of participants who fail to furnish complete profile may be rejected.
12. The Commissionerate of Textiles, Maharashtra State, Nagpur has the right to cancel or amend all or any part of this Contest and/ or the Terms & Conditions/ Technical Parameters/ Evaluation Criteria. However, any changes to the Terms & Conditions/ Technical Parameters/ Evaluation Criteria, or cancellation of the Contest, will be updated/ posted on the MyGov platform.
13. It would be the responsibility of the participants/applicants to keep them informed as to any changes in the Terms & Conditions/ Technical Parameters/ Evaluation Criteria stated for this contest.
14. Commissionerate of Textiles, Maharashtra State, Nagpur will have the right to use the prize winning ‘User Interface Development’, whichever way it may consider suitable, including using it with or without a ‘User Interface Development’. The winner will not exercise any right over his/her ‘User Interface Development’ and shall not use it in any way.

Technical Parameters :

1. The participants must bear in mind that the competition is being organized to enable the Commissionerate of Textiles, Maharashtra State, Nagpur to bear a unique identity, which

should be helpful in leaving an impact in the masses. Hence, the ‘User Interface Development’ should also creatively reflect the welfare aspect of the textile industry.

2. The ‘User Interface Development’ should be a very appealing and message giving.
3. The ‘User Interface Development’ should be usable on the all versions of android as well as IOS/ Windows.
4. **Participants should upload the APK file on the Google drive and have to share its link to MyGov platform only.**
5. A small description (200 words) should be provided to explain the concept.
6. Every participant should use logo of the Commissionerate in their design.
7. The participants must bear in mind that the competition is being organized to enable the Commissionerate of Textiles, Government of Maharashtra, Nagpur to upgrade the user interface of existing android mobile app titled MH-TexApp, and to encourage creativity and innovation among students.
8. The User Interface should not be taken from any readymade template, nor should it have any third party links and references. All coding should be original and free from copyright violations or infringements of intellectual property.
9. The User Interface should be usable on the all versions of android phones available in market.

4. The Buyers should be able to see the geo tagged textile units on Google map.
5. The sellers should be able to edit the existing information like Company Photo, Product Photo, Contact details, phone number and email.
6. The competition is for User Interface. Database structure and format is given just for reference.
7. Participants can use any database of their choice (For Exp SQLite local database)

Prizes:

1. **Phase II:** Winner from phase II will be awarded cash prize of Rs 10,000 (Rupees Ten Thousands only) Sponsored by Ms Embed Creations, Nagpur along with a certificate by Commissionerate.
2. The onus will be on the participant/applicant to prove that he/she is the only authorized representative to send the entry for the Award Scheme.

Selection Procedure:

1. All the entries fulfilling the terms and conditions would be assessed for award by a Selection Committee constituted by Commissionerate of Textiles, Maharashtra State, Nagpur.

2. Entries would be judged on the basis of elements of creativity, originality, composition, technical excellence, simplicity, artistic merit and audio-visual impact.
3. The result of the competition will be uploaded on MyGov platform only
4. The decision of the Selection Committee would be final and binding on all the participating contestants and no clarifications would be issued to any participants for any or their decisions.
5. The disqualified or unrewarded entries shall not be used by the Commissionerate of Textiles, Maharashtra State, Nagpur for any purpose and shall have no intellectual right over the same.
