Sub: Selection of candidates for admission to the First Year of Three Years (SS) Diploma Course in Handloom & Textile Technology- 2022-23.

Sir,

The Institute conducts a Three Years Diploma Course in Handloom & Textile Technology. The Next session of the First Year Diploma Course in Handloom & Textile Technology at this Institute will commence from **16-07-2022**. For selection of candidates to the First Year of D.H.T.T Course, following guidelines are to be observed:-

1. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

(i) Educational Qualification: To be eligible for admission to First Year of Diploma Course in Handloom Textile Technology, the candidate should have **passed 10th Standard** or any equivalent examination with English as a subject of study.

(II) Age Limit:

The age for admission of a candidate should be between **15 and 23 years** and for SC/ST candidates it should be between **15 and 25 years** as on **16th July, 2022**.

2. RESERVATION

Minimum 20% of the total seats allotted to the State are reserved for candidates belonging to Weavers Community. Short fall will be met out from the candidates other than Weavers Community.

So far as reservation of seats for SC/ST is concerned, the respective States will continue to follow their reservation policy.

3. NUMBER OF SEATS

The Government of India has allotted **13 + 01 (Fourteen)** seats for the State at IIIT Bargarh. **Additional One Seat allotted for EWS category.** Apart from that counseling for admission against **02 seats** allotted at IIHT, Venkatagiri will also be conducted from the Merit List of Maharashtra State.

4. FORM OF APPLICATION

(a) You are requested to invite applications in the prescribed proforma for admission to First Year of Diploma in Handloom & Textile Technology either through Press or other media of **wider publicity covering the whole state.**

(b) A copy of the advertisement is required to be sent to this office soon after its publication.

(c) The filled in application forms shall be received at your end **latest by 10th June, 2022.**

5. PREPARATION OF MERIT LIST

(a) Merit List of all the eligible candidates will be prepared by the Selection Committee comprising of Director of Handlooms & Textiles /Director of Industries and Director of this Institute or his representative subject to satisfying the qualifying standard and other eligibility conditions and depending on State reservation policy.

(b) Aggregate of marks obtained in SSC (Std. X) or equivalent qualifying examination shall be the basis for the purpose of determining the merit.

(c) While preparing the merit list, in the event of two candidates scoring identical marks in aggregate, the candidate who had scored more marks in the subjects of Science & Mathematics taken together will stand higher in the merit.

(d) A General merits list consisting of all eligible candidates and a separate merit list for each reserved category with application forms for admission to IIT, Bargah & Venkatagiri shall be submitted to this office by **15th June 2022** for issue of offer of Counseling/Admission to the concerned candidates.

(e) Copy of guidelines for admission issued by the Development Commissioner for Handlooms, New Delhi from time to time is enclosed herewith.

6. STIPEND

Each student admitted into the Course will be paid stipend of Rs. 1,250/- per month in the First Year, Second Year and Third Year of the course by the Central Government. An equal amount of stipend i.e. Rs. 1,250/- per month in the First year, Second year and Third year will be paid by the respective State Government also during the Course. Share of Stipend from the State Government will be paid directly in the account of students after receiving the letter from this Institute thereby giving the details of exact amount of central share paid to them by this institute. **The stipend will be paid in a month subject to fulfillment of the attendance norms i.e. 80% and above. The student with more than one failed paper in previous semester shall not be eligible for getting the stipend.**



Subject : Guidelines for admission to 3 years Diploma course in Handloom & Textile Technology (DHTT) and Post Diploma Course in Textile Processing (PDTP) conducted by Indian Institutes of Handloom Technology in Central Sector as well as State Sectors.

Sir,

It has been decided to amend the procedure for admission to 3 years Diploma course in Handloom & Textile Technology (DHTT) and Post Diploma Course in Textile Processing (PDTP) conducted by Indian Institutes of Handloom Technology in central Sector as well as state Sectors from the academic session 2010-11.

Background

Five Indian Institutes of Handloom Technology (IIHTs) at Varanasi, Salem, Guwahati, Jodhpur & Bargarh are functioning in the Central Sector under the administrative control of Development Commissioner (Handlooms), Ministry of Textiles with an objective to provide professionally qualified manpower to the Indian Handloom Industry. In addition to the above IIHT at Gadag, Venkatagiri & Champa are functioning in the State Sector following the curriculum of the Central Institutes. The Governing Body of IIHTs headed by Development Commissioner for Handlooms is the recommending body for taking various policy decisions and for ratifying various decisions taken in Board of Examiners & Board of Studies.

These IIHTs are conducting 3 years' Diploma Course in Handloom & Textile Technology with total intake capacity 270 students (Salem- 75, Varanasi- 65, Guwahati- 50, Jodhpur- 50 & Bargarh - 30). Besides, IIHT, Salem & Varanasi are also conducting 1-1/2 years Post Diploma Course in Textile Processing with intake capacity of 28 students. Each Institute has its own area of jurisdiction and quota of seats for the respective State.

Existing Procedure for admission to 3 years Diploma in Handloom & Textile Technology(DHTT) Course in IIHTs.

Applications are invited by the respective State Government either through Press or other modes of wide publicity and scrutinized by a Selection Committee comprising Director of Handlooms & Textiles/Director of Industries, their Handloom officials and Director, IIHT

concerned or his representative. The merit list is prepared and finalized on the basis of marks secured by the candidates and forwarded to Director IIHT concerned. The offer of admission are issued in the order of merit & a time period of approximately 15 days is given for reporting for admission to the candidates. In case the candidates from the main list do not turn up, offer is issued to wait-listed candidates in serial order and the process continues till August every year. Unfilled seats are filled on non-stipendiary basis with the approval of HMOT till Oct.

The students are paid stipend @ Rs.400/-, Rs.450/- & Rs.500/- per month for First, Second and Third year respectively, tenable for a period of 10 months per annum. The amount of stipend payable to the students is borne by Central Government and State Government in the ratio of 50:50.

Existing procedure for admission to 1½ years Post Diploma Course in Textile Processing (PDTP) in IIHTs.

Respective Institutes (Salem/Varanasi) invite applications through advertisement in Newspapers for admission to PDTC Course. On receipt of applications, the respective Institute scrutinize them, and prepare a merit list and the offer of admission are issued in the order of merit. A time period of approximately 15 days is given for reporting for admission to the candidates. In case the candidates from the main list do not turn up, offer is issued to wait-listed candidates in serial order and the process continues.

Need for introducing Counseling for admission to DHT & PDTP Course

Under the existing system of admission, it has been observed that Stipendiary & non-Stipendiary students are admitted in the IIHTs till 31st August & 30th October respectively of every year while the academic session starts on 1st July of every year. Thus, there is a big gap in the dates of admission and the date of commencement of the course. As a result, the students are unable to cope up with course and finally it affects the performance of the students and overall result of the IIHT. Thus, to reduce the time gap & to expedite the admission of students, the Government proposes to introduce the admission process of students through Counseling from the academic session 2007-08. Governing Body in its meeting on 20.9.2006 has recommended the admission through counseling.

The guidelines approved for admission to 3 years Diploma course in Handloom Technology (DHT) and Post Diploma Course in Textile Chemistry (PDTC) conducted by Indian Institutes of Handloom Technology in central Sector as well as state Sectors from the academic session 2007-08 is as under:

A. Guidelines for admission to 3 years Diploma course in Handloom Technology (DHT course) through Counseling

1. Respective Institute will send letters regarding admission to State Government concerned for inviting applications in the second week of March.
2. Respective State Governments will invite applications either through press and other mode of wider publicity for admission and receive the filled up application forms.

11. A schedule of counseling/admission for every year is as under:-

12. No TA/DA will be given to candidates for attending the counseling.
13. Entire process of admission should be through FAX, e-mail, Speed post etc to ensure that the process of admission is completed as per schedule.
14. In case, the date mentioned against the activity concerned is a holiday, subsequent working day may be taken as the activity date.
15. Admission Criteria for Diploma course in Handloom Technology (DHT) shall remain same.

B. Guidelines for admission to Post Diploma course in Textile Processing (PDTP) in IIHT, Salem/Varanasi through Counseling.

1. IIHT, concerned will prepare the material for advertisement & will send to Headquarter for publishing the advertisement in Employment News and important news papers through DAVP.
2. After receipt of applications, the merit list will be prepared on the basis of marks and preference of the institutes, for both the Institutes as per the reservation policy applicable to central Government Educational institute.
3. After finalizing the merit list, Indian Institute of Handloom Technology concerned will issue a list of the candidates (equal to the seats allotted to concerned State) for counseling as per schedule according to merit list & invite the candidates for Counseling at the Institute itself.
4. At the time of reporting for counseling before the counseling committee comprising Director, Asstt. Director of Institute concerned at IIHT concerned, the candidates shall be required to produce all certificates in original, medical fitness certificate and one photocopy of each and four copies of their photograph identical to the one pasted on

3. Merit List of all the eligible candidates will be prepared by the Selection Committee comprising Director of Handlooms Textiles/Director of Industries, & Director, IIHT concerned or his representative subject to satisfying the qualifying standard and other eligibility conditions and depending on the State reservation policy and submit to Director, Indian Institute of Handloom Technology concerned.
4. After receiving the merit list from the State Government concerned, the Director, Indian Institute of Handloom Technology concerned will issue a list of the candidates (equal to the seats allotted to concerned State) during the 1st counselling as per schedule according to merit list & invite the candidates for Counseling at the Institute itself. For the IInd & IIIrd Counselling the candidate may be called maximum @ 1:3.
5. At the time of reporting for counseling before the counseling committee comprising Director, Asstt. Director of Institute concerned, Director of Handlooms of the concerned States or his representative in the absence of Asstt. Director of Institute concerned due to any reason or due to other exigencies, Senior faculty Member/ Reader/ Sr. Lecturer can be nominated as a member of Counselling Committee at IIHT concerned, the candidates shall be required to produce all certificates in original, medical fitness certificate and one photocopy of each and four copies of their photograph identical to the one pasted on the application form. If the original certificates are in regional language, duly certified English version/translation of such certificates shall be produced for verification.
6. A candidate who is allotted a seat will be required to pay admission fee only in cash/Demand Draft immediately on the spot at the time of counseling/admission. The fee structure will be intimated to the candidate in the counseling letter. Part payment will not be accepted under any circumstances. If a candidate fails to pay the fee, immediately after the seat is offered to him/her, the offer will be withdrawn and the seat will be allotted to the next candidate in the merit list. In case a candidate drops out after taking admission, his/her full fee will be forfeited.
7. A candidate, who fails to appear in person on the notified date and time for counseling, shall forfeit his/her claim for the seat offered to him/her and such seat will be offered to the next candidate in the merit.
8. Vacancies arising due to cancellation/any other reasons for admission, in DHT course, will be calculated and notified for Second Counseling & invite the remaining candidates who could not get chance in first counseling due to filling up of all the seats at the institute itself.
9. In case State quota is not filled even after the list of eligible candidates of that State is exhausted, inter-State Institute-wise merit list of eligible candidates available will be prepared and 3rd Counseling may be conducted as per the above procedure.
10. Some States are sponsoring candidates of their states to two or more institutes for example Karnataka, A.P, Tamilnadu, Kerala, Pondicherry and Goa are sponsoring their candidates to IIHT, Salem and SPKM IIHT, Venkatagiri/ KHTI Gadag and Maharashtra State to IIHT, Varanasi and SPKM IIHT, Venkatagiri. In such case, the respective State will be required to send the merit list to the IIHT Central sector concerned for conducting the counseling at one place for admission to other Institutes also.



Sub: Revision of eligibility criteria for admission to Diploma/ Post Diploma Course - reg.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to the Minutes of the 45th Governing Body Meeting held on 14.02.2012 on the above cited subject.

In this matter it was decided to relax the eligibility criteria for admission to Diploma and Post Diploma Course as detailed below:

DHTT

A candidate having passed 10th standard or equivalent with English as a subject of study.
Upper age limit to be enhanced from 21 to 23 years for General Candidates and 23 to 25 years in case of SC/ST candidates.

PDTP

A candidate having three years Diploma in Handloom Technology/ Diploma in Handloom & Textile Technology/ Diploma in Textile Technology/ Textile Chemistry/ Textile Processing from a recognized Institute.

OR

Any Science Graduate from a recognized College/ University or B.SC. in Home Science Passed with Physics & Chemistry subjects at 10 +2/ Intermediate level.

The criteria will be implemented from the academic session 2012-13.

2. Other criteria/terms & conditions laid down for admission in the above Course shall remain unchanged.

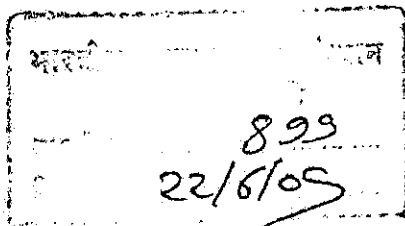

Sir,

This is to inform that considering the recommendations of the Board of Studies of IIHTs, it has been decided that the method of admission to the Diploma in Handloom Technology from the academic session 2006-07 will be, as under-

The admission will be made on the basis of merit by the respective State Governments taking into account the marks secured in qualifying examination only and not interview. However, 5% weightage will continue for those who pass 12th standard with Science. Also, relaxation of 5% for SC/ST candidates will also continue. Reservation of 20% and excess from 20% for candidates belonging to weavers community will also continue, while shortfall will be met out from the candidates other than weavers' community. State-wise quota of seats will remain unaltered until further orders. Respective States will continue to follow their reservation policies. In case of two candidates (one of Xth standard and the other of XIIth standard) securing identical marks in merit, by virtue of weightage of 5% given to XIIth standard i.e. Xth standard marks + 5% weightage, the Xth standard candidate will be on higher merit than the 12th standard candidate, for example:-

Candidate 'A' standard Xth = 75%

Candidate 'B' standard = 70% + 5% = 75%

The candidate 'A' will be on high merit than candidate 'B'

In case of a tie of merits between two candidates passed out 10th standard or a tie between two candidates of 12th standard, the candidate scoring higher marks in Science subject will stand higher in the merit list for example:-

Candidate 'A' standard Xth/XIth=80.5%

Candidate 'B' standard Xth/XIth=80.5%

Candidate 'A' Science* = 160 marks

Candidate 'B' Science* = 150 marks

Then candidate 'A' will be on high merit than candidate 'B'

*Science for 12th standard means Physics and Chemistry


If under extra-ordinary circumstances, all the above conditions remain identical, the eligible candidate having less age will be on higher merit. However, even if these remain identical, the alphabetical order of the name of the candidate will be the criteria for merit i.e. English alphabet A to Z in the decreasing order.

2. It has also been decided to reserve 15% seats for SC & 7.5% seats for ST candidates respectively from the academic session 2006-07 in Post Diploma Course in Textile Chemistry conducted by IIHT, Salem & Varanasi, while the remaining seats may be filled from General category candidate.

3. Further, it has been decided that the subjects viz: Introduction to Textile Manufacture and Textile Testing in First and Third semester of Post Diploma in Textile Chemistry be introduced from the academic session 2006-07. However, the present students will also study Textile Testing Theory in their Third Semester. The syllabus of these subjects and the revised study scheme will be prepared and circulated by the Director, IIHT, Varanasi i.e. the Convener of Board of Studies.
